NOTICE is hereby given that the Voters' List, containing, the names of those persons eligible to vote in the Township of Wellington North 2018 Municipal and School Board Election, will be available from the municipal office at 7490 Sideroad 7 W, Kenilworth, Ontario on **Tuesday, September 4, 2018**.

Starting on September 4th, electors are encouraged to correct any errors or omissions, confirm birth dates or make deletions from the list. All amendments must be made on the prescribed form (EL15), available at the municipal office or at <https://wellington-north.com/>

Completed EL15's may be filed in person, by mail or email by the applicant, or in person by his or her agent.

The Township is using a vote by mail method of election. Ballots will be mailed to all elector's shown on the voter's list the last week of September. If you do not receive a ballot in the mail, please contact the municipal office 519-848-3620. The last date for returning your ballot in the mail is Thursday October 11, 2018. After that it is highly recommended that you deliver your ballot in person to the municipal office.

Election staff will receive applications for the purpose of revising the list Monday to Friday in the from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., **commencing Tuesday, September 4, 2018**.

The office will be open Saturday October 6, 2018 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and office hours are extended to 8:00 pm on Tuesday October 16, 2018 for those requiring assistance to amend the list or for those who wish to deliver their ballot in person.

The last day for making additions, corrections or deletions is Monday, October 22, 2018 (Voting Day).

QUALIFICATION OF ELECTORS

A person is entitled to be an elector (unless prohibited by Section 17(3) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 or any other Act) if he or she:

- a) resides in the local municipality (either an an owner or tenant) or the spouse, or same-sex partner of such owner or tenant;
- b) is a Canadian citizen;
- c) is at least 18 years old;
- d) not prohibited from voting under *The Municipal Act* or any other legislation.
