DELEGATION

Marshall Uretsky, Director – New Program Development, Greater Metro Hockey League

Mr. Uretsky presented a proposal to the Committee to host a Greater Metro Hockey League Junior A team in Arthur. The Greater Metro Hockey League is a hockey company that operates under a pay to play business model. Mr. Uretsky provided background information about the league which began as an alternative to existing Junior Leagues in North America in 2006 - 2007 with 7 locations. They are currently looking to

fill in the South-Western Ontario corridor while being mindful of the proximity amongst the roster of team in order to manage logistics and operating costs. They are hoping to expand by 2 to 3 teams per year. the league is open to several scenarios regarding creation of a new team, including league ownership, league creation with an objective to seek out an individual owner or ownership group, or their preference of attracting the interest of a community or local owner willing to commit to operate a team, and provide information and assistance that will insure the club is in a position to succeed from the outset. A team would require billets for players, daytime ice rental for practices, ice time for games one night per week and a private dressing room. The season runs from the first week of September to April.

The committee questioned how many of the team members would be local and how many would be from other countries and how these players continue their schooling. Mr. Uretsky advised that the league averages 50% Canadian players, 25% from the US and 25% from other countries. Players continue their schooling on line.

Staff was directed to speak with Orangeville, Shelburne and Markdale to obtain information on how this league is run and to find out how many of the leagues teams have competing teams like the Mount Forest Patriots.

The facility manager has offered ice time; but, ice time is not available for the time the league wants.

2) Swimming Season 2015

Final numbers are not in yet as there are some bills that have not come in. Revenues at the Mount Forest pool have increase; however, revenues at the Arthur pool are down. The majority of pool users are youth.

3) Canada 150 Infrastructure Funding Announcement

Wellington North has received funding for Arthur that will be utilized in the 2016 budget.

4) 2015 Recreation Fee Schedule

The current fee schedule was provided for the committee's review. Staff was directed to prepare a 2% fee increase for review at the next meeting.

Committee suggested a tiered pricing system for facilities could increase usage.

BACKGROUND

The Committee is aware that the current Ice Oriented Recreation Agreement between the Township of Southgate and the Township of Wellington North is set to expire December 31, 2015. I've attached as Appendix "A" the current agreement for the Committee's reference.

The agreement reflects Southgate's willingness to provide financial assistance for the "ice oriented" activities at the Mount Forest and District Sports Complex. The Township of Wellington North certainly values the contribution that Southgate has and continues to make to allow the Sports Complex to remain a vibrant and well utilized facility that is the envy of many other municipalities.

Because of the number of variables that impact the operational costs at the Sports Complex (rentals, rental rates, utility costs, wage/benefit costs), I would suggest that the use Consumer Price Index is not an accurate measure when considering phased cost increases. That said I would recommend that the new agreement reflect a fixed cost for the entire term at a figure comparable to the 2014 figure.

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate this 22 Nb day of November, 2012

BETWEEN:

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLINGTON NORTH (hereinafter called "Wellington North") of the FIRST PART

and

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTHGATE (hereinafter called "Southgate") of the SECOND PART

WHEREAS the Council of Wellington North has established the Mount Forest and District Sports Complex (hereinafter called "the Facility") at 850 Princess Street, Mount Forest which, in part, provides recreational services for residents of Southgate;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Wellington North has established a Recreation Department to provide for the operation, maintenance and management of said facility;

AND WHEREAS the Facility is comprised of different sized rooms intended for use on a rental basis by individuals and organizations for social and business gatherings and a Facility providing an ice surface to be used for different "ice oriented" activities including related dressing rooms, a seating area, and a reception lobby;

AND WHEREAS Southgate wishes to provide financial assistance to Wellington North for only the operations of the "ice oriented" part of the Facility;

AND WHEREAS each of the Parties hereto wish to clarify its obligations to the other Party with respect to these matters and to identify more particularly the powers of the Wellington North Recreation Department in relation to the management of this facility;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the mutual covenants of each Party, the one with the other, the Parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The Recreation Department of Wellington North under the direction of the Recreation Director (hereinafter called the "Director") will manage the Mount Forest and District Sports Complex and the programs offered therein (hereinafter called "Facility") on behalf of Wellington North.
- 2. The Director will report in writing to the Recreation & Culture Committee of Wellington North on the operation of the Facility. The report will include financial information and general information with respect to the operation of the facility including information on events being held, major maintenance and repairs, seasonal operations, etc.
- 3. The Director will provide a financial report described in paragraph 2, as it relates to only "ice oriented" activities at the Facility, to the Council of Southgate April 30th, September 30th and a year final financial report.

APPENDIX "A"

- 4. Net annual operating and capital costs for which Southgate is providing assistance will include those costs that relate to the "ice oriented" activities of the Facility including costs and revenues of the arena during the summer season. Operating and capital grants received specifically for the ice oriented operations of the Facility will be included.
- 5. An amount of \$21,900 retroactive to January 1, 2012 and increased annually by the annual change in the Consumer Price Index will be paid to the Township of Wellington North by the Township of Southgate on an annual basis payable:
 - 50% on February 1st each year
 - 25% on September 1st each year, and
 - The balance on Southgate's receipt of the "ice oriented" yearend financial report.
- 6. This amount will be increased annually by the annual change in the Consumer Price Index as of October of the previous year.
- 7. This is a 4 year agreement starting January 1, 2012 and terminating on December 31, 2015. This agreement shall be renegotiated in the second year of each Council term starting in 2015 (2nd year of next term) in advance of the expiration of this document, to extend for another 4 year term.
- 8. Southgate, as part of this agreement, shall appoint one person to act as a liaison representative with respect to the Mount Forest Sports Complex (Recreation & Culture Advisory Committee).
