Wellington North Council recognizes local athletes for Outstanding Achievements in Sports

Dave Reeves credited Kieran and Kennedy's success to their work ethic, dedication and determination. "They are tremendous athletes and great leaders," he said. "They should be proud of everything they have accomplished."
