Teams and athletes chosen to be recognized will be invited to Council Chambers in Kenilworth (7490 Sideroad 7W) on Wednesday, May 7, where they will be presented with a certificate signed by the Mayor, have their photo taken to be shared with the community on social media and local media outlets, and be recognized for their accomplishments in a public forum.
